After considering the record supporting the Proposed Order issued by Hearings Officer Ella D. Johnson on September 27, 1999, the Administrator of the Insurance Division, on behalf of the Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services, hereby affirms, adopts and republishes by this reference the Proposed Order in this Final Order.

ORDER

For violations of ORS 744.013(2)(d) and (g), ORS 744.225 and OAR 836-074-0025, Barlow's Oregon resident insurance agent license, number 117404, shall be revoked pursuant to ORS 744.013(1)(a) and a civil penalty of \$7,000 shall be assessed pursuant to ORS 731.988. For violations of ORS 744.031 and in light of Barlow's violations, the corporate insurance agent license of Barlow Insurance Agency, Inc., number 806368, shall be revoked pursuant to ORS 744.013(1)(a) and (3).

Respondent Agent shall make payment in the form of a check payable to the "Department of Consumer and Business Services" for the full amount due. Payment shall be personally delivered or mailed to the following address:
