The Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services (Director) issues this final order in the above entitled matter pursuant to Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 731.256.

Findings of Fact

Wydra W. Homitz (Homitz) has been licensed as an Oregon resident individual insurance agent since May 1, 1997.

On December 29, 1999, the Director received from the Oregon Student Assistance Commission (OSAC) a notice dated December 27, 1999 that Homitz is in default on a student loan and is not repaying the loan in a satisfactory manner.

Ultimate Finding of Fact

Homitz is in default on a student loan.

Conclusion of Law

The Director is required by ORS 348.393(3) to suspend, without further hearing, the insurance agent license issued to Homitz.

Order

The insurance agent license issued to Homitz is suspended pursuant to ORS 744.013(1)(a) and 348.393(3) from the date of this order until the Director receives from OSAC a written notice that the reason for the suspension no longer exists and the Director determines that Homitz has met all applicable requirements for the license.
