STIPULATION

The Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services (director) commenced this administrative proceeding, pursuant to Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 731.256, to take disciplinary action against American Re-Insurance Company (American Re-Insurance).

American Re-Insurance enters into this Stipulation, pursuant to ORS 183.415(5), to conclude this proceeding without further administrative or judicial proceedings.

American Re-Insurance waives the right to receive a notice of proposed action, to receive a notice of the rights of a party and procedures in contested cases, to have a hearing, to be represented by an attorney at the hearing, and to judicial review of the Final Order.

American Re-Insurance admits and agrees to the following facts, conclusions, and action.

Facts and Conclusions

American Re-Insurance violated ORS 731.574 or 731.488, which ever is applicable, and Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) 836-011-0000 *et seq.* by filing with the director the following document(s) for the calendar year 2001 after the date the document(s) was(were) required to be filed:

- Annual Financial Statement
- Actuarial Opinion
- State Page

Pursuant to ORS 731.988, American Re-Insurance shall pay a civil penalty of \$800.
