) **FINAL ORDER**

) Case No. INS 02-10-019

The Director of the Oregon Department of Consumer and Business Services (director) commenced this administrative proceeding, pursuant to Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 731.256, to take enforcement action against Arthur L. Wornum (Wornum).

On January 15, 2003, the director issued a Notice of Proposed Action, pursuant to ORS 183.415 and related rules. The notice informed Wornum that the director proposed to take certain enforcement action against Wornum, that Wornum was entitled to a hearing, and that Wornum had to request a hearing in writing within 21 days if Wornum wanted a hearing. The notice also informed Wornum that the record of the proceeding then to date, including the designated portion of the Insurance Division's file on Wornum, would automatically become part of the contested case record for purposes of proving a prima facie case if Wornum did not request a hearing within the time allowed to make the request.

The director did not receive a request for a hearing.

The director reviewed the designated portion of the Insurance Division's investigation file on Wornum and found that it proves a prima facie case.

Therefore, director now makes the following final decision in this proceeding in accordance with ORS 731.248 and 183.470, and related rules.

**Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law**

Licensing

Wornum was licensed in Oregon as a resident insurance agent from 11/19/97 to 11/30/00. On 11/30/00, Wornum's license expired because Wornum did not renew it. Wornum's license number was 612412. Wornum's last recorded address was in Beaverton, Oregon.

Failing to Deposit Insurance Premium into Trust Account

Wornum violated ORS 744.225(1) (1999) in 53 instances by, between 7/24/00 and 10/12/00, receiving 53 checks or money orders as payment of insurance premium and depositing them into a business operating account, number 26839-08791, at Bank of America, rather than depositing them into an insurance premium trust account.

**Order**

Pursuant to ORS 744.013(1) (1999), the Oregon license as an insurance agent issued to Wornum shall be revoked on the date of this order.

**Notice of Judicial Review**

Pursuant to ORS 183.480 and 183.482, Wornum may request the Oregon Court of Appeals to review this order by filing a written petition for judicial review with the court within 60 calendar days after the date this order was sent to Wornum.
