The Insurance Division conducted a follow up market conduct examination of County Casualty Insurance Company (Country Casualty) as of 6/30/01. This examination determined that Country Casualty had continued to violate the following statutes and rules which it was found to be violating in the market conduct examination as of 6/30/98.

1. Country Casualty violated OAR 836-080-0225(3) by failing to furnish responses within 30 days of receiving an inquiry from an insured and violated ORS 733.170 by failing to document those responses.
2. Country Casualty violated OAR 836-080-0225(3) by failing to furnish responses to an inquiry that is adequate and answers the questions being raised and violated ORS 733.170 by failing to document those responses.
3. Country Casualty violated ORS 742.502(2)(a) and (b) and OAR 836-054-0000 by issuing policies with uninsured/underinsured motorist liability limits differing from the bodily injury liability limits without obtaining a completed and signed rejection form included with the application.

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
