**STIPULATION**

The Director of the Oregon Department of Consumer and Business Services (director) commenced this administrative proceeding, pursuant to Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 731.256, to take enforcement action against Henry T. Lane, Jr. (Lane).

Lane enters into this stipulation, pursuant to ORS 183.415(5), to conclude this proceeding without further administrative or judicial proceedings.

Lane waives the right to receive a notice of proposed action, receive a notice of the rights of a party and procedures in contested cases, have a hearing, be represented by an attorney at the hearing, receive a proposed order, file exceptions to the proposed order, and have the final order judicially reviewed.

Lane stipulates to the following facts, conclusions, and action; and consents to the issuance of a final order incorporating this stipulation.

**Facts and Conclusions**

Licensing Information

Lane has been licensed in Oregon as a nonresident insurance agent since 1/31/97. Lane's current license number is 137779. Lane's last recorded residence address and business address are located in Gainesville, Florida.

Failed to Report Enforcement Action by Other State Insurance Regulator

Lane violated ORS 744.089(1) in one instances by engaging in the following conduct. ORS 744.089(1) requires a person licensed in Oregon as an insurance agent to notify the Insurance Division of any administrative action taken against the person, and provide a copy of the order, within 30 days of the final disposition of the action. On 1/31/02, the insurance regulator for the State of California issued an

order, number SAC 10565-A, revoking Lane's unrestricted California nonresident insurance agent license and issuing Lane a restricted license for five years subject to certain conditions and restrictions set forth in the order. The insurance regulator took the action because the insurance regulators for eight states took administrative action against Lane. Lane was required to notify the Insurance Division of California's action, and provide a copy of the order, by 2/17/02. Lane has not notified the Insurance Division of the action or provided a copy of the order.

**Action**

Pursuant to ORS 731.988, Lane is assessed a civil penalty of \$200. The payment shall be made in the form of a check payable to the "Department of Consumer and Business Services" for the full amount due. The payment shall be delivered to the Insurance Division at 350 Winter Street NE, Room 440, Salem, OR 97301-3883, or mailed to the Insurance Division at PO Box 14480, Salem, OR 97309-0405. The payment shall be received by the Insurance Division before the date of the final order.
