

AP, revoking Buchanan's California resident insurance producer license effective 6/24/06. The insurance regulator took the action because on 5/16/05, in the Superior Court of San Diego County, Central Division, State of California, in the criminal case *The People of the State of California v. Shanetha Renee Buchanan*, case number CD182302, Buchanan was convicted of committing one count of the crime of welfare fraud, a misdemeanor, pursuant to California Welfare and Institutions Code 10980(C)(2). Buchanan committed the above crime by "...willfully, unlawfully and by means of false statements, representations, impersonations and other fraudulent device, obtain and retain aid for himself/herself or herself for a child(ren) not in fact entitled thereto, in excess of four hundred dollars (\$400.00)."

Order

Pursuant to ORS 744.074(1), Buchanan's Oregon nonresident individual insurance producer license is revoked on the date of this order.

Notice of Right to Judicial Review

A party has the right to judicial review of this final order pursuant to ORS 183.480 and 183.482. A party may request judicial review by sending a petition for judicial review to the Oregon Court of Appeals. The court must receive the petition within 60 days from the date this order was sent to the party.
