STIPULATION

The Director of the Oregon Department of Consumer and Business Services (director) commenced this administrative proceeding, pursuant to Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 731.256, to take enforcement action against Judith A. Boisselle (Boisselle).

Boisselle desires to conclude this proceeding without a hearing by entering into this stipulation pursuant to ORS 183.415(5).

Boisselle waives all rights relative to an administrative hearing and judicial review thereof.

Boisselle stipulates to the following facts, conclusions, action, and to the issuance of a final order incorporating this stipulation.

Facts and Conclusions

Licensing Information

Boisselle has been licensed in Oregon as a resident individual insurance producer since 8/16/96. Boisselle's last recorded residence address is located in Keizer, Oregon.

Failed to Report Criminal Action

Boisselle is subject to enforcement action pursuant to ORS 744.089(2) because of the following circumstances. ORS 744.074(1)(b) permits the director to take any authorized enforcement action against a person who has applied for a license or is licensed in Oregon as an insurance producer if the person violated any insurance statute; or any rule, order or subpoena of the director or the insurance regulator of another state. ORS 744.089(2) requires a person who is licensed in Oregon as an insurance producer to notify the Insurance Division of any criminal prosecution of

the person; and provide a copy of the initial complaint, order resulting from the hearing, and any other relevant legal documents, within 30 days of the pretrial hearing. On or about 11/2/05, in the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for the County of Marion, in the criminal case *State v. Judith Ann Boisselle*, case number 05C53479, Boisselle appeared at a pre-trial hearing to respond to charges that she committed one count of the crime of theft in the first degree, a misdemeanor, pursuant to ORS 161.055; one count of hindering prosecution, pursuant to ORS 162.325; and one count tampering with physical evidence, pursuant to ORS 162.295. Boisselle committed the crime of theft by receiving electronic and computer equipment, valued at \$200 or more, which had been stolen by her son, Dan Boisselle, from McNary High School in Keizer, Oregon on or about 6/20/05. Boisselle committed the crime of hindering prosecution by concealing the stolen equipment to prevent it being used to prosecute her son for stealing the equipment. Boisselle committed the third crime by removing the stolen equipment to make it unavailable to use to prosecute her son for stealing the equipment. Thus, Boisselle was required to notify the Insurance Division of the criminal action, and provide a copy of the available specified documents, by 12/2/05. However, Boisselle did not notify the Insurance Division of the action or provide a copy of the specified documents. Instead, Boisselle notified her employer on or shortly after she was arrested on 10/7/05, and her employer notified the Insurance Division on 12/8/06.

Convicted of Crime

Boisselle is subject to enforcement action pursuant to ORS 744.074(1)(f) because of the following circumstances. ORS 744.074(1)(f) permits the director to take any authorized enforcement action against a person who has applied for a license or is licensed in Oregon as an insurance producer if the person was convicted of a misdemeanor involving dishonesty or breach of trust, a felony, or an offense punishable by death or imprisonment under the laws of the United States. On 11/30/06, Boisselle was convicted of committing the three crimes as described above.

Action

As consideration for the director not further investigating or taking enforcement action against Boisselle, Boisselle surrenders her Oregon resident insurance producer license effective on the date of this stipulation and agrees to never apply for or renew any license authorized by ORS Chapter 744.
