



ORS 25.780(1). The certification included the information specified in ORS 25.750(1).

On 8/18/10, the director issued an order, case number INS 10-08-006, suspending Prentice's license pursuant to ORS 744.074(1) and ORS 25.780(1) from 8/18/10 until (1) the director receives from the Oregon Department of Justice a written notice pursuant to ORS 25.774 that the director may reinstate or renew the suspended license or issue a new license, and (2) Prentice qualifies for a license.

ORS 25.774 states in part that “[w]hen, at any time after suspension under ORS 25.750 to 25.783, the conditions resulting in the suspension no longer exist, the administrator [as defined in ORS 25.010(1)] shall so notify the issuing entity and shall confirm that the license, certificate, permit or registration may be reinstated contingent upon the requirements of the issuing entity.”

On 11/3/10, the director received from the Oregon Department of Justice a written notice pursuant to ORS 25.774 that the director may reinstate or renew the suspended license or issue a new license “because the reasons for suspension no longer exist.” The director does not have any reason to believe that Prentice does not otherwise qualify for a license.

### **Order**

Pursuant to ORS 25.774, Prentice's Oregon resident individual insurance producer license is no longer suspended effective the date of this order.

### **Notice of Right to Judicial Review**

A party has the right to judicial review of this order pursuant to ORS 183.480 and ORS 183.482. A party may request judicial review by sending a petition for judicial review to the Oregon Court of Appeals. The court must receive the petition within 60 days from the date this order was served on the party. If the order was personally delivered to a party, then the date of service is the date the party received the order. If the order was mailed to a party, then the date of service is the date the order was mailed to the party, not the date the party received the order.
