The Director of the Oregon Department of Consumer and Business Services (director) commenced this administrative proceeding, pursuant to Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 731.256, to terminate enforcement action against Shawn J. Stewart (Stewart).

The director makes the following final decision in this proceeding.

Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law

Licensing Information

Stewart has been licensed in Oregon as a resident individual insurance producer since 6/19/08. Stewart's license number is 734716, and NAIC national producer number is 10630860. Stewart's last recorded residence and business address is 551 Corona Loop Road, Roseburg, OR 97471-9391; residence telephone number is 541-580-6313; business telephone number is 541-677-0172; and e-mail address is shawnjstewart@gmail.com.

License No Longer Subject to Suspension Pursuant to ORS 25.750 to 25.783

Stewart is no longer subject to enforcement action pursuant to ORS 25.774 because of the following circumstances. ORS 25.780(1) requires an “entity that issues licenses, certificates, permits or registrations that a person is required by state law to possess to engaged in an occupation, [or] profession ...to suspend without further hearing the license, certificate, permit or registration of a person upon certification by the administrator [as defined in ORS 25.010(1)] that the person is subject to an order suspending the license, certificate, permit or registration. The certification must include the information specified in ORS 25.750(1).”

On 1/24/11, the director received from the Oregon Department of Justice a Notice to Suspend dated 1/20/11 certifying that Stewart is subject to an order suspending Stewart's Oregon resident individual insurance producer license pursuant to ORS 25.780(1). The certification included the information specified in ORS 25.750(1). On 1/31/11, the director issued an order, case number INS 11-01-002, suspending Stewart's license pursuant to ORS 744.074(1) and ORS 25.780(1) from 1/31/11 until (1) the director receives from the Oregon Department of Justice a written notice pursuant to ORS 25.774 that the director may reinstate or renew the suspended license or issue a new license, and (2) Stewart qualifies for a license.

ORS 25.774 states in part that "[w]hen, at any time after suspension under ORS 25.750 to 25.783, the conditions resulting in the suspension no longer exist, the administrator [as defined in ORS 25.010(1)] shall so notify the issuing entity and shall confirm that the license, certificate, permit or registration may be reinstated contingent upon the requirements of the issuing entity.

On 5/25/11, the director received from the Oregon Department of Justice a Notice to Reinstate dated 5/24/11 pursuant to ORS 25.774 informing the director that the director may reinstate Stewart's license "because the reasons for suspension no longer exist." The director does not have any reason to believe that Stewart does not otherwise qualify for a license.

Order

Pursuant to ORS 25.774, Stewart's Oregon resident individual insurance producer license is no longer suspended effective the date of this order.

Notice of Right to Judicial Review

A party has the right to judicial review of this order pursuant to ORS 183.480 and ORS 183.482. A party may request judicial review by sending a petition for judicial review to the Oregon Court of Appeals. The court must receive the petition within 60 days from the date this order was served on the party. If the order was personally delivered to a party, then the date of service is the date the party received the order. If the order was mailed to a party, then the date of service is the date the order was mailed to the party, not the date the party received the order. If
