Pursuant to Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 731.256, the Director of the Oregon Department of Consumer and Business Services (director), by and through the Insurance Division, commenced this administrative proceeding to take enforcement action against American Home Assurance Company, Chartis Casualty Company, Chartis Property Casualty Company, Commerce and Industry Insurance Company, Granite State Insurance Company, Illinois National Insurance Company, National Union Fire Insurance Company of Pittsburgh, PA, New Hampshire Insurance Company, and The Insurance Company of the State of Pennsylvania (collectively referred to herein as "Chartis.")¹


On 10/15/12, Chartis entered into a multi-state regulatory settlement agreement. The agreement will become effective if certain conditions are met.

Pursuant to ORS 183.417(3), the director adopts, and incorporates herein by this reference, the agreement, and orders that the following action be taken, if and when such agreement becomes effective.

Action

Chartis shall comply with the agreement as it applies to Oregon. Any monetary penalties paid to Oregon pursuant to the agreement shall be considered a civil penalty pursuant to ORS 731.988.
