The Director of the Oregon Department of Consumer and Business Services (director), by and through the Insurance Division, commenced this administrative proceeding, pursuant to Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 731.256, to take enforcement action against David E. Williams (Williams).

The director makes the following final decision in this proceeding.

Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law

Licensing Information

Williams has been licensed in Oregon as a resident individual insurance adjuster from 12/14/99 to 7/31/09 and since 9/2/09. Williams' license is scheduled to expire on 7/31/13. Williams' license number is 616384, and NAIC national producer number is 6235440. Williams' last recorded residence address is 7100 SW Newton Place, Portland, OR 97225-2047; and telephone number is 503-679-8488. Williams' last recorded business address is Mercury Adjusting Services, Inc., 8630 SW Scholls Ferry Road Suite 121, Beaverton, OR 97008-6621 and telephone number is 503-531-8869.

License Subject to Suspension Pursuant to ORS 25.750 to 25.783

Williams is subject to enforcement action pursuant to ORS 25.780(1) because of the following circumstances. ORS 25.780(1) requires an "entity that issues licenses, certificates, permits or registrations that a person is required by state law to possess to engaged in an occupation, [or] profession ...to suspend without further hearing the license, certificate, permit or registration of a person upon certification by the administrator [as defined in ORS 25.010(1)] that the person is subject to an order suspending the license, certificate, permit or registration. The certification must include the information specified in ORS 25.750(1)." On 12/3/12, the director

received from the Oregon Department of Justice a notice to suspend dated 11/29/12 certifying that Williams is subject to an order suspending Williams' Oregon insurance adjuster license pursuant to ORS 25.780(1). The certification included the information specified in ORS 25.750(1).

Order

Pursuant to ORS 25.780(1), Williams' Oregon resident individual insurance adjuster license is suspended and shall not be renewed, and any other license authorized by ORS Chapter 744 shall not be issued to Williams, from the date of this order until the director receives from the Oregon Department of Justice a written notice pursuant to ORS 25.774 that the director may reinstate or renew the suspended license or issue a new license, and the director issues an order terminating the suspension.

Notice of Right to Judicial Review

A party has the right to judicial review of this order pursuant to ORS 183.480 and ORS 183.482. A party may request judicial review by sending a petition for judicial review to the Oregon Court of Appeals. The court must receive the petition within 60 days from the date this order was served on the party. If the order was personally delivered to a party, then the date of service is the date the party received the order. If the order was mailed to a party, then the date of service is the date the order was mailed to the party, not the date the party received the order. If a party files a petition, the party is requested to also send a copy of the petition to the Insurance Division by delivering or mailing it to the Insurance Division at Labor and Industries Building, 350 Winter Street NE Room 300, Salem, Oregon 97301-3880; or mailing it to PO Box 14480, Salem, OR 97309-0405; or faxing it to 503-378-4351; or e-mailing it to mitchel.d.curzon@state.or.us.
