STIPULATION

The Director of the Oregon Department of Consumer and Business Services (director), and through the Insurance Division, commenced this administrative proceeding, pursuant to Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 731.256, to take enforcement action against American Safety Casualty Insurance Company (American Safety).

American Safety desires to conclude this proceeding without a hearing by entering into this stipulation pursuant to ORS 183.417(3).

American Safety waives all rights relative to an administrative hearing and judicial review thereof.

American Safety stipulates to the following facts, conclusions, action, and to the issuance of a final order incorporating this stipulation.

American Safety understands that the stipulation and final order is a public record and shall be posted permanently on the Insurance Division's website.

Facts and Conclusions

Licensing Information

American Safety has been licensed in Oregon as an insurer since 9/15/1982. American Safety's NAIC number is 39969 and federal employer identification number is 58-2056755. American Safety's last recorded business mailing address is 100 Galleria Parkway SE Suite 700, Atlanta, GA 30339-5947; and telephone number is 770-485-4355.

Filed Special Oregon Schedule P Late


American Safety is subject to enforcement action pursuant to ORS 731.574(1) because of the following circumstances. ORS 731.574(1) requires a person who is licensed in Oregon as an insurer to file with the director an annual financial statement, and permits the director to require additional information. In the annual statement instructions, the director requires an insurer that is authorized to transact workers' compensation insurance in Oregon to file additional information about the insurer's workers' compensation

premiums and losses during the preceding calendar year and calculate the amount of the insurer's special workers' compensation deposit required by ORS 731.628. An insurer is required to file the additional information even if the insurer did not have any premiums or losses in Oregon during the preceding calendar year. The additional information is reported on a form called a Special Oregon Schedule P. A Special Oregon Schedule P is required to be filed by March 1 of each year for the preceding calendar year. At all relevant times, American Safety was authorized to transact workers' compensation insurance in Oregon and filed its Special Oregon Schedule P for 2013. American Safety was required to file its Special Oregon Schedule P for 2013 by 3/3/14. American Safety filed its Special Oregon Schedule P for 2013 on 3/4/13, one day late.

Action

Pursuant to ORS 731.988(1), American Safety is assessed a civil penalty of \$100. The payment shall be made in the form of a check payable to the "Department of Consumer and Business Services" for the full amount due. The payment shall be delivered or mailed to the Insurance Division at the Labor and Industries Building, 350 Winter Street NE Room 300, Salem, OR 97301-3880; or mailed to the Insurance Division at PO Box 14480, Salem, OR 97309-0405. The payment shall be received by the Insurance Division before the date of the final order.


