History of the Proceeding

The Director of the Oregon Department of Consumer and Business Services (director), by and through the Insurance Division, commenced this administrative proceeding, pursuant to Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 731.256, to take enforcement action against Michelle L. Collup (Collup).

The director issued a notice of proposed action on 2/11/14 and an amended notice on 3/20/14 pursuant to ORS 183.415 proposing to revoke Collup's Oregon nonresident individual insurance producer license pursuant to ORS 744.074. On 3/3/14, Collup requested a hearing. On 3/4/14, the director referred this case to the Office of Administrative Hearings to schedule and if necessary conduct a hearing. On 6/2/14, the director filed with OAH a motion for summary determination pursuant to Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) OAR 137-003-0580. On 6/5/14, OAH scheduled a hearing to be held on 9/11/14. OAH issued a proposed order on 7/29/14 and an amended order on 7/30/14 granting the director's motion, cancelling the hearing, and finding that Collup violated the laws as alleged in the notice.

The director did not receive from the party any exceptions to the amended proposed order.

The director now makes the following final decision in this proceeding.

Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Opinion

The director adopts, and incorporates herein by this reference, the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and reasoning of the amended proposed order as the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and reasoning of this final order.


Order

Pursuant to ORS 744.074(1), Collup's Oregon nonresident individual insurance producer license is revoked on the date of this order.

Notice of Right to Judicial Review

A party has the right to judicial review of this order pursuant to ORS 183.480 and ORS 183.482. A party may request judicial review by sending a petition for judicial review to the Oregon Court of Appeals. The court must receive the petition within 60 days from the date this order was served on the party. If the order was personally delivered to a party, then the date of service is the date the party received the order. If the order was mailed to a party, then the date of service is the date the order was mailed to the party, not the date the party received the order. If a party files a petition, the party is requested to also send a copy of the petition to the Insurance Division by delivering it to the Labor and Industries Building, 350 Winter Street NE Room 300, Salem, OR 97301-3880; or mailing it to PO Box 14480, Salem, OR 97309-0405; or faxing it to 503-378-4351; or e-mailing it to mitchel.d.curzon@state.or.us.


