The Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services for the State of Oregon ("Director"), pursuant to the authority set forth in ORS 744.074, and having reviewed the files and records of the Oregon Insurance Division, makes the following:

Findings of Fact:

1. David J. Wild ("Wild") has applied for an Oregon Resident Insurance Producer's License ("License").
2. As part of the application process, Wild completed and submitted to the Director an application form indicating that he had never been convicted of a misdemeanor.
3. Wild's criminal history shows that Wild was convicted of Criminal Mischief in the Second Degree on December 19, 2011, in Washington County, Oregon.

Conclusions:

1. Under ORS 731.988(1) the Director may impose a civil penalty upon any individual who violates a provision of the Insurance Code.
2. Under ORS 744.074(1)(a) the Director may refuse to issue a License, or take any other action authorized by the Insurance Code, if an applicant provides incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.
3. Criminal Mischief in the Second Degree is specifically listed as a crime subject to review under OAR 836-072-0015 to -0020 to determine whether an applicant is fit to be issued a License. Accurate information about a conviction for Criminal Mischief in the Second Degree is consequently material to the Director's decision whether to issue a License.
4. Wild's indication in his application that he had not been convicted of Criminal Mischief in the Second Degree was incorrect and materially untrue.

Based upon the foregoing, the Director finds it appropriate to issue a License to Wild, subject to a civil penalty of \$500 for providing incorrect or materially untrue information in a license application.

Stipulation to Order and Civil Penalty:

Wild stipulates to the foregoing facts and agrees that in consideration of the Director's issuance of a License he will pay a civil penalty of \$500.

The Director hereby imposes a civil penalty of \$500 (Five Hundred Dollars).

In further consideration of the Director's issuance of a License, Wild consents to entry of this order, including the civil penalty of \$500, and hereby waives any and all hearing rights as well as any rights to judicial or administrative review of this order.






