10 ORDER TO CEASE AND DESIST,
11 FINAL ORDER TO ISSUE LICENSE,
12 FINAL ORDER ASSESSING CIVIL
13 PENALTY AND CONSENT TO
14 ENTRY OF ORDER

16 The Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services for the State
17 of Oregon (“Director”), acting in accordance with Oregon Revised Statutes (“ORS”)
18 chapters 731, 732, 733, 734, 735, 737, 742, 743, 743A, 744, 746, 748 and 750
19 (“Insurance Code”) and specifically ORS 744.074, has conducted an investigation into
20 the Oregon Nonresident Insurance Producer License application of Amy Long (“Long”).

21 Long wishes to resolve and settle this matter with the Director.

22 Now, therefore, as evidenced by the signature(s) subscribed on this Order, Long
23 hereby CONSENTS to entry of this Order.

24 FINDINGS OF FACT

25 The Director FINDS that:

26 1. Long applied for an Oregon Nonresident Insurance Producer License
27 (“License”) on or around July 22, 2015.

28 2. As part of the application process, Long completed and submitted to the
29 Division of Financial Regulation (“Division”), formerly the Insurance Division, an
30 application form indicating that she had never been named or involved as a party in an
31 administrative proceeding.

1 3. During review of the application, the Division learned that Long was subject
2 to a previous administrative proceeding in Washington. On April 9, 2014, Long was
3 involved in an administrative proceeding in Washington that resulted in an order
4 revoking Long's Washington license. File No. 14-0067.

5 4. After the application was filed, and the prior administrative action was
6 discovered, Long admitted to being the subject of that action.

7
8 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

9 The Director **CONCLUDES** that:

10 5. Accurate information about an applicant's history of administrative action is
11 material to the Director's decision whether to issue a License.

12 6. Long's representation in her application that she had never been named or
13 involved as a party in an administrative proceeding was incorrect, misleading,
14 incomplete, or materially untrue.

15 7. Under ORS 744.074(1)(a), the Director may refuse to issue an insurance
16 producer license and may take other actions authorized by the Insurance Code in lieu
17 thereof or in addition thereto, if an applicant provides incorrect, misleading, incomplete
18 or materially untrue information in the license application.

19 8. Under ORS 731.988(1) the Director may impose a civil penalty upon any
20 individual who violates a provision of the Insurance Code.

21
22 **ORDERS**

23 Now therefore, the Director issues the following Orders:

24 9. As authorized by ORS 731.252(1), the Director **ORDERS** Long to **CEASE**
25 **AND DESIST** from violating any provision of the Insurance Code or the administrative
26 rules promulgated thereunder.



1 10. Based upon the foregoing and in accordance with ORS 731.988(1), the
2 Director ORDERS that a Nonresident Insurance Producer License be issued to Long,
3 subject to a CIVIL PENALTY of five hundred dollars (\$500) for providing incorrect,
4 misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.

5 11. The CIVIL PENALTY assessed herein is due and payable within ten days of
6 the entry of this Order.
