9 ORDER TO CEASE AND DESIST,
10 FINAL ORDER TO ISSUE LICENSE,
11 FINAL ORDER ASSESSING CIVIL
12 PENALTY AND CONSENT TO
13 ENTRY OF ORDER

14 The Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services for the State
15 of Oregon (“Director”), acting in accordance with Oregon Revised Statutes (“ORS”)
16 chapters 731, 732, 733, 734, 735, 737, 742, 743, 743A, 744, 746, 748 and 750
17 (“Insurance Code”) and specifically ORS 744.074, has conducted an investigation into
18 the Oregon Resident Insurance Producer License application of Nathan L. Jasper
19 (“Jasper”).

20 Jasper wishes to resolve and settle this matter with the Director.

21 Now, therefore, as evidenced by the signature(s) subscribed on this Order, Jasper
22 hereby CONSENTS to entry of this Order.

23 FINDINGS OF FACT

24 The Director FINDS that:

- 25 1. Jasper applied for an Oregon Resident Insurance Producer License
26 (“License”) on or around November 6, 2015.
- 27 2. As part of the application process, Jasper completed and submitted to the
28 Division of Financial Regulation (“Division”), formerly the Insurance Division, an
29 application form indicating that he had never been convicted of a felony or misdemeanor.
- 30 3. During review of the application, the Division learned that Jasper was
31 convicted in Douglas County Circuit Court on August 29, 2014 of Harassment, a
32 misdemeanor.
- 33 4. After the application was filed, and his prior criminal conviction was
34 discovered, Jasper admitted to being the subject of the misdemeanor conviction.

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CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Director CONCLUDES that:

5. Accurate information about an applicant’s history of criminal conviction is material to the Director’s decision whether to issue a License.

6. Jasper’s representation in his application that he had not been convicted of a misdemeanor was incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue.

7. Under ORS 744.074(1)(a), the Director may refuse to issue an insurance producer license and may take other actions authorized by the Insurance Code in lieu thereof or in addition thereto, if an applicant provides incorrect, misleading, incomplete or materially untrue information in the license application.

8. Under ORS 731.988(1) the Director may impose a civil penalty upon any individual who violates a provision of the Insurance Code.

ORDERS

Now therefore, the Director issues the following Orders:

9. As authorized by ORS 731.252(1), the Director ORDERS Jasper to CEASE AND DESIST from violating any provision of the Insurance Code or the administrative rules promulgated thereunder.

10. Based upon the foregoing and in accordance with ORS 731.988(1), the Director ORDERS that a Resident Insurance Producer License be issued to Jasper, subject to a CIVIL PENALTY of \$250 for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.

11. The CIVIL PENALTY assessed herein is due and payable within ten days of the entry of this Order.
