ORDER TO CEASE AND DESIST,
FINAL ORDER TO ISSUE LICENSE,
FINAL ORDER ASSESSING CIVIL
PENALTY AND CONSENT TO
ENTRY OF ORDER

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10 The Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services for the State
11 of Oregon (“Director”), acting in accordance with Oregon Revised Statutes (“ORS”)
12 chapters 731, 732, 733, 734, 735, 737, 742, 743, 743A, 744, 746, 748 and 750
13 (“Insurance Code”) and specifically ORS 744.074, has conducted an investigation into
14 the Non-Resident Insurance Producer License application of Koby Leach (“Applicant”).

15 Applicant wishes to resolve and settle this matter with the Director.

16 Now, therefore, as evidenced by the signature(s) subscribed on this Order,
17 Applicant hereby CONSENTS to entry of this Order.

19 FINDINGS OF FACT

20 The Director FINDS that:

- 21 1. Applicant has applied for a Non-Resident Insurance Producer License
22 (“License”). Applicant’s national producer number is 17863754.
23 2. As part of the application process, Applicant completed and submitted to the
24 Division of Financial Regulation (“Division”), an application form indicating that she had
25 never been subject to administrative action.
26 3. During review of the application, the Division learned that Applicant was

1 subject to administrative action in Washington in 2016.

2 4. After the application was filed, the prior administrative action was discovered
3 and Applicant admitted to being the subject of that action.

4 5. Applicant indicated on that application form that she had been convicted of a
5 misdemeanor, but failed to provide the required supporting documents. Applicant
6 provided the supporting documents for the criminal conviction after the information was
7 requested by the Division.

8
9 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

10 The Director CONCLUDES that:

11 6. Accurate information about an applicant's history of administrative action and
12 criminal conviction is material to the Director's decision whether to issue a License.

13 7. Applicant's representation in her application that she had not been subject to
14 administrative action was incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue.

15 8. Applicant's failure to provide documentation regarding the misdemeanor
16 conviction left her application incomplete.

17 9. Under ORS 731.260, no person shall file with the Director any application
18 known to be false or misleading.

19 10. Under ORS 744.074(1)(a), the Director may refuse to issue an insurance
20 producer license and may take other actions authorized by the Insurance Code in lieu
21 thereof or in addition thereto, if an applicant provides incorrect, misleading, incomplete
22 or materially untrue information in the license application.

23 11. Under ORS 731.988(1) the Director may impose a civil penalty of up to
24 \$1,000 per violation upon any individual who violates a provision of the Insurance Code.

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ORDERS

Now therefore, the Director issues the following Orders:

12. As authorized by ORS 731.252(1), the Director ORDERS Applicant to CEASE AND DESIST from violating any provision of the Insurance Code or the administrative rules promulgated thereunder.

13. Based upon the foregoing and in accordance with ORS 731.988(1), the Director ORDERS that a Non-Resident Insurance Producer License be issued to Applicant, subject to a CIVIL PENALTY of \$250 for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.

14. The CIVIL PENALTY assessed herein is due and payable at the time this Order is returned to the Division.
