Respondent.

On June 15, 2016, the Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services (“Director”), by and through the Division of Financial Regulation (“Division”), properly served Notice on DELANEY DAWN DE LA BARRA (“Respondent”) that the Director intended to revoke Respondent’s Oregon resident insurance producer license (“License”).

The Notice offered Respondent an opportunity for a hearing, if requested within 30 days. The Notice further informed Respondent that if a hearing was not conducted because Respondent did not timely request a hearing or otherwise defaulted, then the designated portion of the Director’s file and all materials submitted by Respondent in this case would automatically become part of the contested case record for the purpose of proving a *prima facie* case.

The Director did not receive from Respondent a request for a hearing and did not conduct a hearing.

The Director finds that the record of this proceeding proves a *prima facie* case.

The Director makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, Orders, and Notice of Right to Judicial Appeal.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Director FINDS that:

3 license if having admitted or been found to have committed any unfair trade practice or  
4 fraud related to insurance. The Director may revoke Respondent's License because  
5 Respondent admitted to submitting three policies for the purpose of meeting her quarterly  
6 quota.

7 ORDER

8 Now therefore, the Director issues the following Orders:

9 9. As authorized by ORS 731.252(1), the Director ORDERS Respondent to  
10 CEASE AND DESIST from violating any provision of the Insurance Code or the  
11 administrative rules promulgated thereunder.

12 10. The Director, pursuant to ORS 744.074(1)(g), hereby REVOKES  
13 Respondent's Oregon resident insurance producer license.
