FINAL ORDER TO CEASE AND
DESIST, FINAL ORDER TO ISSUE
LICENSE, FINAL ORDER
ASSESSING CIVIL PENALTY AND
CONSENT TO ENTRY OF ORDER

The Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services for the State of Oregon (“Director”), acting in accordance with Oregon Revised Statutes (“ORS”) chapters 731, 732, 733, 734, 735, 737, 742, 743, 743A, 744, 746, 748 and 750 (“Insurance Code”) and specifically ORS 744.074, has conducted an investigation into the nonresident insurance producer license application of Dean R. Paulsen (“Applicant”).

Applicant wishes to resolve and settle this matter with the Director.

Now, therefore, as evidenced by the signature(s) subscribed on this Order, Applicant hereby CONSENTS to entry of this Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Director FINDS that:

1. Applicant applied for a nonresident insurance producer license (“License”) on May 9, 2016. Applicant’s national producer number is 5772710.

2. As part of the application process, Applicant completed and submitted to the Division of Financial Regulation (“Division”) an application form indicating that he had never been subject to administrative action.

1 3. During review of the application, the Division learned that Applicant was
2 subject to administrative action, WAOIC No. 86043, in Washington on January 7, 2016,
3 which resulted in a fine of \$2,750.00.

4 4. After the application was filed, and the prior administrative action was
5 discovered, Applicant admitted to being the subject of that action.

6 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

7 The Director CONCLUDES that:

8 5. Accurate information about an applicant's history of administrative action is
9 material to the Director's decision whether to issue a License.

10 6. Applicant's representation in his application that he had not been subject to
11 administrative action was incorrect, misleading, incomplete or materially untrue.

12 7. Under ORS 731.260, no person shall file with the Director any application
13 known to be false or misleading.

14 8. Under ORS 744.074(1)(a), the Director may refuse to issue an insurance
15 producer license and may take other actions authorized by the Insurance Code in lieu
16 thereof or in addition thereto, if an applicant provides incorrect, misleading, incomplete
17 or materially untrue information in the license application.

18 9. Under ORS 731.988(1) the Director may impose a civil penalty of up to
19 \$1,000 per violation upon any individual who violates a provision of the Insurance Code.

20 ORDERS

21 Now therefore, the Director issues the following Orders:

22 10. As authorized by ORS 731.252(1), the Director ORDERS Applicant to
23 CEASE AND DESIST from violating any provision of the Insurance Code or the
24 administrative rules promulgated thereunder.

25 11. Based upon the foregoing and in accordance with ORS 731.988(1), the
26 Director ORDERS that a nonresident insurance producer license be issued to Applicant,



1 subject to a CIVIL PENALTY of \$500 for providing false or misleading information in a
2 license application.

3 12. The CIVIL PENALTY assessed herein is due and payable at the time this
4 Order is returned to the Division.
