ORDER TO VACATE SUSPENSION
OF INSURANCE PRODUCER
LICENSE

8 Respondent.

9 The Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services for the State
10 of Oregon (“Director”), acting in accordance with Oregon Revised Statutes (“ORS”)
11 chapters 731, 732, 733, 734, 735, 737, 742, 743, 743A, 744, 746, 748 and 750
12 (“Insurance Code”) and ORS 25.774, hereby vacates the suspension of the resident
13 insurance producer license (“License”) of RONALD A. JOHNSON (“Respondent”).

14 The Director makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and
15 Orders.

16 FINDINGS OF FACT

17 The Director FINDS that:

18 1. Respondent has been licensed through the Division of Financial Regulation,
19 previously known as the Insurance Division (“Division”), as an Oregon resident
20 insurance producer since February 1, 1995. Respondent’s License is scheduled to expire
21 on September 30, 2016. His NAIC national producer number is 6263822.

22 2. On August 9, 2016, the Department of Justice Judgment Enforcement Unit, on
23 behalf of the State of Oregon Child Support Program (“CSP”), issued a Notice to
24 Suspend Respondent’s License to the Division.

25 3. The CSP Notice to Suspend states that Respondent has an order to pay current
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1 child support, owes the greater of more than three times the monthly child support
2 obligation or \$2,500 in child support arrears, and has not entered into a payment
3 agreement with CSP.

4 4. The Notice to Suspend issued by CSP states that proper notice and
5 opportunity to contest the suspension have been provided pursuant to ORS 25.750
6 through ORS 25.783.

7 5. A person may not sell, solicit or negotiate insurance in this state for any class
8 or classes of insurance unless the person is licensed as an insurance producer under ORS
9 744.053.

10 6. On August 17, 2016, the Director, pursuant to ORS 25.750 and the Insurance
11 Code, issued an administrative order #SS-16-0325, Order Suspending Insurance Producer
12 License (“Order”) until such time as all conditions of reinstatement are met, as provided
13 by ORS 25.774. The Order provided that the suspension is effective upon service upon
14 Respondent.

15 7. The Order was served by certified mail addressed to Respondent and
16 deposited in the mail on August 17, 2016.

17 8. On September 9, 2016, the CSP issued to the Division a Notice to Reinstate
18 Respondent’s insurance producer license, subject to the Division’s reinstatement
19 requirements, because the reasons for the suspension no longer exist. The notice was
20 received by the Division on September 14, 2016.

21 9. A suspension of an insurance producer license is a reportable event.

22
23 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

24 The Director CONCLUDES that:

25 10. Respondent is licensed with the Division as an “insurance producer” as
26 defined by ORS 731.104 at the time CSP issued the notice.



1 11. Respondent's License is a license required by the Oregon Insurance Code in
2 order to engage in the occupation or profession of an insurance producer.

3 12. Pursuant to ORS 25.774 and the CSP's Notice to Reinstate, dated September
4 9, 2016, the reasons for Respondent's license suspension no longer exist.

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ORDER

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Now therefore, the Director issues the following Orders:

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13. Pursuant to ORS 25.750 and 25.765(3), hereby **VACATES THE ORDER**
SUSPENDING the resident insurance producer license of Respondent.

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14. The effective date of this Order is the day this Order is served on the
Respondent. The entry of this Order in no way limits further remedies which may be
available to the Director under Oregon law.
