ORDER TO CEASE AND DESIST,
FINAL ORDER TO ISSUE LICENSE,
FINAL ORDER ASSESSING CIVIL
PENALTY AND CONSENT TO
ENTRY OF ORDER

The Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services for the State of Oregon (“Director”), acting in accordance with the Oregon Revised Statutes (“ORS”) chapters 731, 732, 733, 734, 735, 737, 742, 743, 743A, 744, 746, 748 and 750 (“Insurance Code”) and specifically ORS 744.074, has conducted an investigation into the Resident Insurance Producer License application of Kathryn Judycki (“Applicant”).

Applicant wishes to resolve and settle this matter with the Director.

Now, therefore, as evidenced by the signature(s) subscribed on this Order, Applicant hereby CONSENTS to entry of this Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Director FINDS that:

1. Applicant has applied for a Resident Insurance Producer License (“License”).
2. As part of the application process, Applicant completed and submitted to the Division of Financial Regulation (“Division”), formerly the Insurance Division, an application form indicating that she had never been convicted of a felony or misdemeanor.
3. During review of the application, the Division learned that Applicant was convicted of Obstructing a Police Officer and Assault in Yakima Municipal Court,

2 4. After the application was filed, and the prior criminal conviction was
3 discovered, Applicant admitted to being the subject of that conviction.

4 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

5 The Director CONCLUDES that:

6 5. Accurate information about an applicant's history of criminal conviction is
7 material to the Director's decision whether to issue a License.

8 6. Applicant's representation in her application that she had not been convicted
9 of a misdemeanor or felony was incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue.

10 7. Under ORS 731.260, no person shall file with the Director any application
11 known to be false or misleading.

12 8. Under ORS 744.074(1)(a), the Director may refuse to issue an insurance
13 producer license and may take other actions authorized by the Insurance Code in lieu
14 thereof or in addition thereto, if an applicant provides incorrect, misleading, incomplete
15 or materially untrue information in the license application.

16 9. Under ORS 731.988(1) the Director may impose a civil penalty of up to
17 \$1,000 per violation upon any individual who violates a provision of the Insurance Code.

18 ORDERS

19 Now therefore, the Director issues the following Orders:

20 10. As authorized by ORS 731.252(1), the Director ORDERS Applicant to
21 CEASE AND DESIST from violating any provision of the Insurance Code or the
22 administrative rules promulgated thereunder.

23 11. Based upon the foregoing and in accordance with ORS 731.988(1), the
24 Director ORDERS that a Resident Insurance Producer License be issued to Applicant,
25 subject to a CIVIL PENALTY of \$250 for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete,
26 or materially untrue information in a license application.
