WHEREAS the Director of the Department of Consumer & Business Services for the State of Oregon (the “Director”) acting by the authority of Oregon Debt Collection Agency Law, ORS 697.005 through 697.115 (hereinafter “Collection Agency”) has reviewed Accurate Collection Services, LLC’s (“Accurate”) application for registration as a Collection Agency; and determined that it is appropriate to issue a conditional registration;

WHEREAS Accurate wishes to resolve this matter with the Director;

NOW THEREFORE, as evidenced by the authorized signatures subscribed on this order, Accurate hereby **CONSENTS** to entry of this order of conditional registration upon the Director’s Findings of Facts and Conclusions of Law as stated hereinafter:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1) Accurate Collection Services, LLC was registered with the Oregon Secretary of State as a





1 domestic limited liability company on January 8, 2009. Their principle place of business is listed
2 as 708 Main Street Suite 204, Oregon City, Oregon 97045. Taci Philbrook is the owner of
3 Accurate (hereinafter collectively “Applicants”).

4 2) On March 16, 2010, Taci Philbrook, as the owner of Accurate signed an application for
5 registration as a Collection Agency on behalf of the Applicants. The Applicants failed to answer
6 question number 10, on the application which asked: “Have you or anyone working for you ever
7 been convicted of a felony or an offense involving fraud or deception?”

8 3) On July 23, 2010, at the Director’s request, Applicants submitted an updated application
9 that contained an affirmative response to question 10. Applicants included an explanation that
10 stated: “Jason Bryant – Burglary II, sentenced September 2001 . . .”

11 4) On August 31, 2010 at the Director’s request, Jason Bryant submitted and explanation of
12 his convictions stating that he was convicted of: “2 charges of burglary and 2 charges of
13 aggravated theft.”

14 5) The Director conducted an independent investigation and determined that Jason Bryant
15 was convicted on July 31, 2002 in Washington County Case No. C013053CR of the following
16 felonies:

- 17 i. Theft in the first degree committed on July 25, 2001;
- 18 ii. Burglary in the second degree committed on July 26, 2001;
- 19 iii. Theft in the first degree committed on July 26, 2001;
- 20 iv. Robbery in the third degree committed on August 25, 2001.

21 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

22 1. The Director has jurisdiction over the business activities and registration application of
23 Applicants pursuant to ORS 697.005 through 697.115.

24 2. Jason Bryant, a person employed by the Applicants, was convicted of felonies in
25 Washington County Circuit Court case number C013053CR and therefore, pursuant to ORS

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1 697.039(1)(g) the Director may refuse to issue a registration to the Applicants.

2 3. Jason Bryant, a person employed by the Applicants, engaged in dishonest, fraudulent, or
3 illegal practices when he committed the acts of burglary, theft, and robbery and therefore
4 pursuant to ORS 697.039(1)(f) the Director may refuse to issue a registration to the Applicants.

5 **ORDER**

6 The Director, pursuant to ORS 697.031, **ISSUES A CONDITIONAL**
7 **REGISTRATION** for Accurate Collection Services, LLC. The registration for Accurate is
8 conditioned on Jason Bryant not being employed by, performing any services for, or working as
9 an agent of, Accurate Collection Services, LLC. If the Director determines that Jason Bryant
10 has performed any services on behalf of Applicants at anytime after the issuance of this
11 conditional registration; the registration shall be null and void as of that date and Applicants will
12 be subject, jointly and severally, to a \$1,000 civil penalty for each violation of the collection
13 agency act including but not limited to acting as an unregistered collection agency. The
14 conditions upon which this registration is granted shall remain in force for each subsequent
15 registration renewal unless explicitly removed by Order of the Director.

16 The date of the Order is the date the Director signs the Order. The entry of this Order in
17 no way limits further remedies which may be available to the Director under Oregon law.
