- 25 2. the Receiver's recommended Rehabilitation Plan as described in the Status Report
- 26 is hereby approved;

1 3. all members of OHC and all entities that have provided services to members of
2 OHC that assert a claim against OHC must submit final claims for services rendered by
3 midnight, PDT, October 31, 2016;

4 4. the Receiver is authorized to issue notice to claimants, including, but not limited
5 to, publishing web announcements of the October 31, 2016 claims submission deadline;


6 5. the Receiver is authorized to continue ongoing operational activities in the
7 receivership as he deems necessary and appropriate;

8 6. the Receiver is authorized to continue asset recovery efforts as he deems
9 necessary and appropriate;

10 7. the Receiver continues to be authorized under ORS 734.150 and ORS 734.220
11 and the terms of the Stipulated Order entered by this court on July 11, 2016 until further
12 order of this court; and

13 8. that stipulated order of July 11, 2016 remains in effect in its entirety, and all
14 parties remain bound by all the provisions set forth therein, including, but not limited to,
15 those prohibiting any attempt to control any asset of OHC, recover any claim against
16 OHC, or interfere with the receivership.
