In general, the CHIP plan or OHP+ for children has no frequency limits on exams, lenses, frames or contacts, it's just what is medical necessity for children. Even if they have issues and break a pair of glasses weekly they are not limited due to any policy decisions regarding OHP coverage for children. Limits on contacts are really only those that would be age related and standard in the practice, again, what is medically necessary.
