FINAL ORDER TO CEASE AND
DESIST, ORDER ALLOWING
SURRENDER OF NONRESIDENT
INSURANCE PRODUCER LICENSE,
AND CONSENT TO ENTRY OF
ORDER

Respondent.

The Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services for the State of Oregon ("Director"), acting in accordance with Oregon Revised Statutes ("ORS") chapters 731, 732, 733, 734, 735, 737, 742, 743, 743A, 743B, 744, 746, 748 and 750 ("Insurance Code") and specifically ORS 744.074, has conducted an investigation of the nonresident insurance producer license activities of Dana Abdullah ("Respondent").

Respondent wishes to resolve this matter with the Director and wishes to surrender her Oregon nonresident insurance producer license.

Now, therefore, as evidenced by the signature subscribed herein, Respondent hereby CONSENTS to the entry of this Order.

The Director makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Orders.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Director FINDS that:

1. Respondent is a Florida resident with her last recorded address at 8874 Hogan Road, Jacksonville, FL 32216.
2. On October 18, 2024, the Oregon Division of Financial Regulation ("Division"), received an application for an Oregon nonresident insurance producer license from Respondent.

3. On that same day, Respondent tendered payment of the fee for her license using an electronic check and was issued a license upon entry of her payment information.

4. On February 26, 2025, the National Insurance Producer Registry (“NIPR”), where the application is submitted along with the licensing fees, notified the Division that the fees paid had not been honored by Respondent’s bank.

5. On February 26, 2025, the Division sent an email warning to Respondent that her payment was not honored and also provided instructions regarding how to submit payment. The Division noted that if her fees were not paid within 30 days, her license would be made inactive until payment was made, and if payment was not made by March 27, 2025, the matter would be referred to the Enforcement Unit for administrative action.

6. On April 2, 2025, the Division having received no response and no payment, placed Respondent's license status to inactive.

7. On July 15, 2025, the Division called Respondent's business number on file and was cut off. A voicemail was left that the past due license fees must be paid no later than July 18, 2025, to avoid administrative action.

8. As of the time of this Order, Respondent has still not paid her license fee.

9. Respondent is no longer working in the insurance industry and has requested to surrender her nonresident insurance producer license.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Director CONCLUDES that

10. Under ORS 731.252(1), whenever the Director has reason to believe that any person has been engaged or is engaging or is about to engage in any violation of the Insurance Code, the Director may issue an order to discontinue or desist from such violation or threatened violation.

11. ORS 744.059(1)(d) requires insurance producer licensees to pay “all applicable fees” for their license.





12. Respondent violated ORS 744.059(1)(d) by failing to pay the license fee.

13. ORS 744.074(1)(p) authorizes the Director to suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew an insurance producer license for "failing to pay any fee or charge" to the Director.

ORDERS

The Director ISSUES the following ORDERS:

14. Pursuant to ORS 731.252(1) the Director hereby ORDERS Respondent, and all entities owned or controlled by Respondent, her successors and assignees, to CEASE AND DESIST from violating any provision of the Insurance Code, or any administrative rule adopted by the Director under those statutes.

15. The Director hereby grants Respondent's request to surrender Respondent's Oregon nonresident insurance producer license, in lieu of revocation of such license.

16. This Order is a "Final Order" under ORS 183.310(6)(b). Subject to that provision, the entry of this Order does not limit other remedies that are available to the Director under Oregon law.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
