FINAL ORDER ASSESSING CIVIL
PENALTY, ENTERED BY
DEFAULT

On December 10, 2025, the Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services for the State of Oregon (“Director”), by and through the Division of Financial Regulation (“Division”), and acting in accordance with Oregon Revised Statute (“ORS”) 646A.593 (the “Data Broker Law”), properly served notice (the “Notice”) on Digital Safety Products, LLC (“Respondent”) that it proposed to assess a civil penalty against Respondent for violating certain provisions of the Data Broker Law.

The Notice offered Respondent an opportunity for a hearing if requested within 20 days. The Notice further informed Respondent that if a hearing was not conducted because Respondent did not timely request a hearing or otherwise defaulted, then the designated portion of the Director’s file and all materials submitted by Respondent in this case would automatically become part of the contested case record for the purpose of proving a *prima facie* case.

The Director did not receive a hearing request from Respondent and did not conduct a hearing.

The Director finds that the record of this proceeding proves a *prima facie* case.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Director FINDS that:

1. Respondent is a California corporation with a principal place of business located at 1804 Garnet Ave, Suite 409, San Diego, CA 92109.
