The Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services for the State of Oregon (“the Director”), acting in accordance with Oregon Revised Statutes (“ORS”) chapters 731, 732, 733, 734, 735, 737, 742, 743, 743A, 744, 746, 748 and 750 (“the Insurance Code”) and ORS 25.750 and 25.765(3), hereby suspends the resident insurance producer license (“License”) of Christopher Lee Wagner (“Wagner”).

The Director makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Director FINDS that:

1. Wagner was first licensed as an Oregon resident insurance producer on January 20, 2012. His License expires on September 30, 2026.
2. Wagner’s NAIC National Producer Number is 6260966.
3. On January 21, 2026, the Polk County District Attorney, on behalf of the State of Oregon Child Support Program (“CSP”), issued to the Division of Financial Regulation (“the Division”) a Notice to Suspend Wagner’s License.
4. The CSP Notice to Suspend states that Wagner has an order to pay child support and owes arrears equal to the greater of three months of support or \$2,500, and has failed to make the payments agreed upon with CSP.

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1 5. The Notice to Suspend issued by CSP states that proper notice and an
2 opportunity to contest the suspension have been provided under ORS 25.750 through
3 25.783.

4 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

5 The Director CONCLUDES that:

6 6. Under ORS 744.053, a person may not sell, solicit or negotiate insurance in
7 Oregon for any class or classes of insurance unless the person is licensed as an insurance
8 producer.

9 7. Wagner is licensed as an “insurance producer” as defined by ORS 731.104.

10 8. Wagner’s License is a license required by the Oregon Insurance Code for him
11 to engage in the occupation or profession of an insurance producer.

12 9. Pursuant to ORS 25.750, Wagner’s License is subject to suspension by the
13 Director because CSP has certified to the Division that:

14 A. The Department of Justice maintains Wagner’s child support record;

15 B. Wagner is subject to an order to pay child support;

16 C. Wagner owes child support arrears equal to the greater of more than three times
17 the monthly child support obligation or \$2,500;

18 D. Wagner entered into an agreement with CSP and failed to make the established
19 payments; and

20 E. Proper notice and an opportunity to contest the suspension have been provided
21 by CSP pursuant to ORS 25.750 through ORS 25.783.

22 ORDER

23 Now therefore, the Director issues the following Order:

24 10. Pursuant to ORS 25.750 and 25.765(3), the Director hereby SUSPENDS the
25 resident insurance producer license of Wagner until such time as all conditions of
26 reinstatement have been met, as provided by ORS 25.774.



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11. This Order is effective on the date it is served on Wagner.

12. The entry of this Order in no way limits further remedies which may be available to the Director under Oregon law.
