STIPULATION

The Director of the Oregon Department of Consumer and Business Services (director) commenced this administrative proceeding, pursuant to Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 731.256, to take enforcement action against Bankers Fidelity Life Insurance Company (BFLIC).

BFLIC desires to conclude this proceeding without a hearing by entering into this stipulation pursuant to ORS 183.415(5).

BFLIC waives all rights relative to an administrative hearing and judicial review thereof.

BFLIC stipulates to the following facts, conclusions, action, and to the issuance of a final order incorporating this stipulation.

Facts and Conclusions

Licensing Information

BFLIC has been licensed in Oregon as a foreign insurer since 7/9/96. BFLIC's last recorded principal business address is located in Atlanta, Georgia.

Made False Statement to the Director

BFLIC is subject to enforcement action pursuant to ORS 731.260 because of the following circumstances. ORS 731.260 prohibits a person from filing or causing to be filed with the director any article, certificate, report, statement, application or any other information required or permitted to be so filed under the Insurance Code and known to such person to be false or misleading in any material respect. On 8/26/05, the Insurance Division, on behalf of the director, received from BFLIC a filing dated 8/24/05. The Insurance Division assigned the filing number MH 0053 05. The filing included eight policy forms. One of the eight forms was an Accidental

Expense Policy, form number B 8790-1. The filing included a Certificate of Compliance dated 8/24/05 which stated in relevant part "I, the undersigned authorized filer, hereby certify that the filing submitted complies with the applicable Oregon laws and applicable filing requirements and product standards set forth on the Insurance Division's web site and that the filing is not false or misleading in any material respect." The certificate was signed by Susan Roberts of BFLIC. The filing did not include the required product standards, form number 440-3631. So on 8/30/05 the Insurance Division requested BFLIC send the product standards form to be included with the filing. On 9/5/05, the Insurance Division received from BFLIC the product standards form. One of the standards, on page 6 of 15, pursuant to ORS 743.053, required the policy to make "benefits cover losses for at least 180 days after the accident." BFLIC inserted on the product standards form "Pg 5-Par 3" thereby representing that the policy, on page 5 paragraph 3 of the policy form, complied with the standard. However, the policy made death benefits payable if, *inter alia*, death occurred "within 90 days of the date of the Insured's accidental bodily injury." Thus, the policy did not comply with the standard and BFLIC' representation otherwise was false.

Action

Pursuant to ORS 731.988, BFLIC is assessed a civil penalty of \$10,000. The payment shall be made in the form of a check payable to the "Department of Consumer and Business Services" for the full amount due. The payment shall be delivered to the Insurance Division at the Labor and Industries Building, 350 Winter Street NE, Room 440 (4th Floor), Salem, Oregon; or mailed to the Insurance Division at PO Box 14480, Salem, OR 97309-0405. The payment shall be *received* by the Insurance Division by the date of the final order.
