STIPULATION

The Director of the Oregon Department of Consumer and Business Services (director) commenced this administrative proceeding, pursuant to Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 731.256, to take enforcement action against Pennsylvania General Insurance Company (Pennsylvania General).

Pennsylvania General desires to conclude this proceeding without a hearing by entering into this stipulation pursuant to ORS 183.417(3).

Pennsylvania General waives all rights relative to an administrative hearing and judicial review thereof.

Pennsylvania General stipulates to the following facts, conclusions, action, and to the issuance of a final order incorporating this stipulation.

Facts and Conclusions

Licensing Information

Pennsylvania General has been licensed in Oregon as a foreign insurer since 3/8/56. Pennsylvania General's last recorded principal business address is located in Canton, Massachusetts.

Filed OIGA Recoupment Assessment Certification Late

Pennsylvania General is subject to enforcement action pursuant to Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) 836-031-0855(8) because of the following circumstances. ORS 734.550 requires all insurers who are licensed in Oregon as insurers and authorized to transact generally property and casualty insurance to be members of the Oregon Insurance Guaranty Association (OIGA). ORS 734.570(3) requires OIGA to assess its member insurers an amount necessary to pay OIGA's expenses. If OIGA assesses its member insurers, then a member insurer must either recoup the assessment from its insureds pursuant to ORS 734.579(1), expense any amount

unrecouped pursuant to OAR 836-031-0855(7), or payback or carry over any excess amount recouped pursuant to OAR 836-031-0855(9), and annually file with the director a certification pursuant ORS 734.579(2) and OAR 836-031-0855(8). OAR 836-031-0855(8) requires a member insurer to file a certification on a form specified by the director by June 1 of each year following the completion of a 12-month recoupment assessment period referred to in OAR 836-031-0855(6). At all relevant times, Pennsylvania General was a member insurer of OIGA, was assessed by OIGA, and recouped or otherwise disposed of the assessment. Pennsylvania General was required to file its certification for 2009 by 6/1/10. Pennsylvania General filed its certification for 2009 on 8/13/10, 73 days late.

Action

Pursuant to ORS 731.988(1), Pennsylvania General is assessed a civil penalty of \$7,300. The payment shall be made in the form of a check payable to the "Department of Consumer and Business Services" for the full amount due. The payment shall be delivered or mailed to the Insurance Division at the Labor and Industries Building, 350 Winter Street NE Room 300, Salem, Oregon 97301-3880; or mailed to the Insurance Division at PO Box 14480, Salem, OR 97309-0405. The payment shall be *received* by the Insurance Division by the date of the final order.
