STIPULATION

The Director of the Oregon Department of Consumer and Business Services (director) commenced this administrative proceeding, pursuant to Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 731.256, to take enforcement action against The Union Labor Life Insurance Company (Union Labor Life).

Union Labor Life desires to conclude this proceeding without a hearing by entering into this stipulation pursuant to ORS 183.417(3).

Union Labor Life waives all rights relative to an administrative hearing and judicial review thereof.

Union Labor Life stipulates to the following facts, conclusions, action, and to the issuance of a final order incorporating this stipulation.

Facts and Conclusions

Licensing Information

Union Labor Life has been licensed in Oregon as a foreign insurer since 9/24/56. Union Labor Life's last recorded principal business address is located in Washington, DC.

<u>Issued Group Life Insurance Policy to Unapproved Trust</u>

Union Labor Life is subject to enforcement action pursuant to ORS 743.354(1) because of the following circumstances. ORS 743.354(1) prohibits an insurer from offering a group life insurance policy to a trust as the policyholder or from offering coverage under such a policy insuring a person residing in this state, whether issued in this or another state, unless the director determines that the association satisfies certain requirements. Union Labor Life issued two group life insurance policies to two trusts insuring persons residing in Oregon. Before it issued each

policy, Union Labor Life did not file with the director information about the trust pursuant to ORS 743.354(4) and therefore the director did not determine that the trust satisfied the applicable requirements.

<u>Issued Group Health Insurance Policy to Unapproved Trust</u>

Union Labor Life is subject to enforcement action pursuant to ORS 743.526(1) because of the following circumstances. ORS 743.526(1) prohibits an insurer from offering a group health insurance policy to a trust as the policyholder or from offering coverage under such a policy insuring a person residing in this state, whether issued in this or another state, unless the director determines that the trust satisfies certain requirements. Union Labor Life issued two group health insurance policies to two trusts insuring persons residing in Oregon. Before it issued each policy, Union Labor Life did not file with the director information about the trust pursuant to ORS 743.526(3) and therefore the director did not determine that the trust satisfied the applicable requirements.

Action

Pursuant to ORS 731.988(1), Union Labor Life is assessed a civil penalty of \$10,000. The payment shall be made in the form of a check payable to the "Department of Consumer and Business Services" for the full amount due. The payment shall be delivered or mailed to the Insurance Division at the Labor and Industries Building, 350 Winter Street NE Room 300, Salem, Oregon 97301-3880; or mailed to the Insurance Division at PO Box 14480, Salem, OR 97309-0405. The payment shall be *received* by the Insurance Division by the date of the final order.
