### **STIPULATION**

The Director of the Oregon Department of Consumer and Business Services (director) commenced this administrative proceeding, pursuant to Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 731.256, to take enforcement action against American Home Assurance Company (American Home).

American Home desires to conclude this proceeding without a hearing by entering into this stipulation pursuant to ORS 183.417(3).

American Home waives all rights relative to an administrative hearing and judicial review thereof.

American Home stipulates to the following facts, conclusions, action, and to the issuance of a final order incorporating this stipulation.

## **Facts and Conclusions**

## <u>Licensing Information</u>

American Home has been licensed in Oregon as a foreign insurer since 4/1/35. American Home's Oregon Insurance Division company number is 1019, NAIC entity number is 19380, and federal employer identification number (FEIN) is 13-5132990. Over Recouped OIGA Assessment from Insureds

American Home is subject to enforcement action pursuant to ORS 734.579(1) because of the following circumstances. ORS 734.550 requires a person that is licensed in Oregon as an insurer and authorized to transact generally property and casualty insurance to be a member of the Oregon Insurance Guaranty Association (OIGA). ORS 734.570(3) requires OIGA to assess its member insurers an amount necessary to pay OIGA's expenses. If OIGA assesses its member insurers, then ORS 734.579(1) requires a member insurer to recoup its assessment from its

insureds, unless otherwise permitted by Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) 836-031-0855. However, if a member insurer recoups its assessment from its insureds, it may not recoup more than its assessment. American Home was a member insurer of OIGA and was assessed by OIGA. American Home had recouped all of its assessment by 2006. However, American Home continued to recoupe \$2,497 in 2007 and \$12,926 in 2009 for a total of \$15,423.

#### Action

Pursuant to ORS 731.988(1), American Home is assessed a civil penalty of \$20,000. The payment shall be made in the form of a check payable to the "Department of Consumer and Business Services" for the full amount due. The payment shall be delivered or mailed to the Insurance Division at the Labor and Industries Building, 350 Winter Street NE Room 300, Salem, Oregon 97301-3880; or mailed to the Insurance Division at PO Box 14480, Salem, OR 97309-0405. The payment shall be *received* by the Insurance Division by the date of the final order.
