10 The Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services for the State
11 of Oregon (“Director”), acting in accordance with Oregon Revised Statutes (“ORS”)
12 chapters 731, 732, 733, 734, 735, 737, 742, 743, 743A, 744, 746, 748 and 750
13 (“Insurance Code”) and specifically ORS 744.074, has conducted an investigation into
14 the nonresident insurance producer license application of MICHAEL EUGENE
15 JENKINS (“Applicant”).

16 Applicant wishes to resolve and settle this matter with the Director.

17 Now, therefore, as evidenced by the signature(s) subscribed on this Order,
18 Applicant hereby CONSENTS to entry of this Order.

20 FINDINGS OF FACT

21 The Director FINDS that:

- 22 1. Applicant applied for a nonresident insurance producer license (“License”) on
23 October 27, 2016. Applicant’s national producer number is 18168267.

25 2. As part of the application process, Applicant completed and submitted to the
26 Division of Financial Regulation (“Division”) an application form indicating that he had

1 been convicted of a felony.

2 3. Applicant was convicted of a felony driving under the influence in Prince
3 William County in Virginia, case number CR10001642-00, on December 15, 2010.

4 4. Applicant was placed on probation in his resident State of Virginia on October
5 25, 2016 for two years.

6 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

7 The Director CONCLUDES that:

8 5. Under Oregon Revised Statutes (“ORS”) 744.074(1)(f), the Director may
9 place a licensee on probation or suspend, revoke or refuse to issue or renew an insurance
10 producer license for having been convicted of a felony punishable by imprisonment under
11 the laws of the United States. The record of the conviction shall be conclusive evidence
12 of the conviction.

13 ORDERS

14 Now therefore, the Director issues the following Orders:

15 6. As authorized by ORS 731.252(1), the Director ORDERS Applicant to
16 CEASE AND DESIST from violating any provision of the Insurance Code or the
17 administrative rules promulgated thereunder.

18 7. Based on the foregoing and in accordance with ORS 744.074(1)(f), the
19 Director ORDERS that Applicant’s nonresident insurance producer license include the
20 following probationary conditions for the term of two years:

- 21 a. Applicant will obey all federal, state and local laws.
- 22 b. Applicant will comply with all applicable insurance statutes, rules and
23 regulations.
- 24 c. Applicant will report to the Director any criminal prosecution of the
25 insurance producer taken in any jurisdiction no later than the 30th day after the initial
26 pretrial hearing date, per ORS 744.089(2). The report shall include a copy of the initial



1 complaint filed, the order resulting from the hearing and any other relevant legal
2 documents.

3 d. Applicant will report to the Director any administrative action taken against
4 the insurance producer in another jurisdiction or by another governmental agency in this
5 state not later than the 30th day after the date of the final disposition of the matter, per
6 ORS 744.089(1).

7 e. The term of this probation will be for two years from the date of entry of
8 this Order without further action by the Division unless the probation period is extended
9 by the Director.

10 f. If Applicant fails to comply with the conditions of this License, Applicant
11 agrees to notify the Division of the failure to meet the conditions and surrender the
12 License immediately. If Applicant fails to surrender the License within seven days of
13 providing notification to the Division or from the date that the Division notifies Applicant
14 that the Director believes that there has been a violation of this Order, whichever is
15 earlier, Applicant agrees that his License shall be revoked immediately.
