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Schedule P by 1	March I	of each	year
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- 5. On January 14, January 29, and February 13, 2020, e-mail notices were sent to Selective to remind the company that its Special Oregon Schedule P for 2019 was due on March 1, 2020. All notices stated that filing the form late will incur a civil penalty of \$500 a day.
- 6. Selective filed its Special Oregon Schedule P for 2019 on April 9, 2020, thirtyeight (38) days after the due date.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Director CONCLUDES that:

- Under ORS 731.252(1), whenever the Director has reason to believe that any person has been engaged or is engaging or is about to engage in any violation of the Insurance Code, the Director may issue an order to discontinue or desist from such violation or threatened violation.
- 8. ORS 731.574(1) authorizes the Director to require workers' compensation insurers to file a Special Oregon Schedule P by March 1 of each year.
- 9. By filing its Special Oregon Schedule P thirty-eight (38) days past the due date, Selective violated ORS 731.574(1).
- ORS 731.988(1) authorizes the Director to impose upon Selective a civil 10. penalty of up to \$10,000 per violation of ORS 731.574(1).

ORDERS

Now therefore, the Director issues the following Orders:

- 11. Pursuant to ORS 731.252(1), the Director ORDERS Selective to CEASE AND DESIST from violating ORS 731.574(1).
 - 12. Pursuant to ORS 731.988(1), the Director ORDERS Selective to pay a CIVIL
