CEASE AND DESIST ORDER AND CONSENT TO IMPOSITION OF CIVIL PENALTIES

WHEREAS the Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services for the State of Oregon (hereinafter "the Director") conducted an investigation of I-Net Mortgage Corporation, and determined that I-Net Mortgage Corporation engaged in

activities constituting violations of ORS 59.840 through 59.965 (hereinafter []the Oregon

Mortgage Lender Law[]); and

WHEREAS I-Net Mortgage Corporation wishes to resolve and settle this matter with the Director:

NOW THEREFORE, as evidenced by the authorized signatures subscribed on this order I-Net Mortgage Corporation hereby CONSENTS to entry of this order upon the Director S Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law as stated hereinafter:

#### FINDINGS OF FACT

The Director FINDS that:

1. I-Net Mortgage Corporation (hereinafter "Respondent"), incorporated in Etah on October 31, 1997 engages in residential mortgage transactions in Oregon real property in expectation of compensation.

- 2. The Director has licensed Respondent to engage in Oregon residential mortgage lending since September 4, 2002.
  - 3. Gregory S. Cutt is the owner of Respondent.
- 4. Respondent did not provide notice to the Director within 30 days following the hire of Noah Thompson to act as a loan originator.
- 5. Respondent did not amend the application to provide notice to the Director of the hire of Noah Thompson to act as a loan originator for Respondent.
- 6. Respondent did not provide notice to the Director containing the name of the loan originator, the start date of the loan originator, the current business and home address, date of birth, telephone number and e-mail address of the loan originator, the social security number or a physical description of the loan originator and a certification of compliance by the loan originator with the provisions of ORS 59.937(2), 59.969(4)(a) and (b) and 59.971 within 30 days following the loan originator's date of hire.
- 7. The advertisement placed by Respondent contained a simple annual rate stated in conjunction with an annual percentage rate, however the annual percentage rate was not the same size font as the simple annual rate and the annual percentage rate was not located in same location as the simple annual rate making the simple annual rate more conspicuous than the annual percentage rate.

### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

## The Director CONCLUDES that:

- 1. Respondent violated ORS 59.969(1) by failing to provide to the Director notice of the hire of a loan originator within 30 days following the date of hire of the loan originator.
- 2. Respondent violated OAR 441-880-0030(2) by failing to amend the application for the hire of a loan originator within 30 days following the date of hire of the loan originator.

3. Réspondent violated OAR 441-880-0030(3) by failing to provide notice to the Director the name of the loan originator, the start date of the loan originator, the current business and home address, date of birth, telephone number and e-mail address of the loan originator, the social security number or a physical description of the loan originator and a certification of compliance by the loan originator with the provisions of ORS 59.937(2), 59.969(4)(a) and (b) and 59.971 within 30 days following the loan originator's date of hire.

4. Respondent violated 12 CFR 226.24(b) by advertising the simple annual rate in manner more conspicuous than the annual rate.

## **ORDER**

The Director, pursuant to ORS 59.885(4), hereby **ORDERS** that I-Net Mortgage Corporation will **CEASE AND DESIST** from violating any provision of Oregon Mortgage Lender Law, OAR 441-850-0005 through 441-885-0010 and any rule, order, or policy issued by the Division.

The Director, pursuant to ORS 59.996 hereby **ORDERS** I-Net Mortgage Corporation to pay the State of Oregon a civil penalty of \$5,000 based upon the failure to notify of the loan originator and \$5,000 for advertising in violation of 12 CFR 226.24(b).

The Director suspends payment of \$5,000 of the assessed civil penalties for a three year period. If in the period between the date of the Order to three years from the date of the Order, I-Net Mortgage Corporation violates any provision of the Oregon Mortgage Lender Law, OAR 441-850-0005 through 441-885-0010 or any rule, order, or policy issued by the Division, the suspended portion of the assessed civil penalty will become immediately due and payable. If I-Net Mortgage Corporation does not violate

the Oregon Mortgage Lender Law, OAR 441-850-0005 through 441-885-0010 or any rule, order, or policy issued by the Division in the three year period, the suspended portion of the civil penalty is waived. The date of the Order is the date the Director signs the Order.

The entry of this Order in no way limits further remedies which may be available to the Director under Oregon law.
