ORDER SUPPLEMENTING
ORDER OF SUPERVISION

On April 13, 2026, the Director, Department of Consumer and Business Services, Division of Financial Regulation (the “Director”), pursuant to ORS 750.055(1)(b) and (1)(e), ORS 731.385, ORS 734.043(2), and OAR 836-013-0110, issued an Order of Supervision (the “Order”) immediately placing ATRIO Health Plans, Inc. (the “Company”), an Oregon corporation and Oregon-domiciled health care service contractor (NAIC Company Code 10123), under supervision.

The Director has determined that the Company has taken steps to significantly improve their policyholders’ surplus, and the Company is no longer in a hazardous financial condition on that basis. But certain conditions giving rise to the supervision, as described in the Order, still exist. Accordingly, pursuant to ORS 734.047(2), the Director hereby supplements and extends the period of supervision under the Order for a period ending on the earlier of (i) a determination by the Director that the Company has no unpaid claims over 60 days outside the ordinary course of business and has otherwise continued its present progress toward resolving the remaining conditions giving rise to the supervision, and (ii) 60 calendar days from the date of this order.
