

EXTENSION OF DCBS ORDER

The Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services for the State of Oregon, acting under the authority in ORS 731.870, issued an order effective March 25, 2020 through April 23, 2020, directing all insurers transacting insurance in Oregon to extend deadlines for reporting claims, institute grace periods for premium payment, suspend cancellations and non-renewals, and provide other specified relief to Oregon insureds. The director extended the duration of this order on April 23, 2020 to be in effect through May 23, 2020, again on May 22, 2020 to be in effect through June 22, 2020, and again on June 22, 2020 to be in effect through July 22, 2020.

The director issued a Health Insurance Order, effective May 5, 2020 through June 3, 2020, and issued an extension through July 3, 2020. The Health Insurance Order extended and modified the relief insurers are to provide to Oregon insureds and terminated this Order for health insurers, with the exception of accidental death and dismemberment, disability, and long term care coverage.

The director issued a Disability and Life Insurance Order, a Long Term Care Insurance Order, and a Property and Casualty Insurance Order, effective May 24, 2020 through June 22, 2020, and subsequently extended through July 22, 2020. These orders extended and modified the relief insurers are to provide to Oregon insureds and terminated this order for disability and life insurers, long term care insurers, and property and casualty insurers.

The director has determined that the COVID-19 outbreak in Oregon, which resulted in a state of emergency,¹ continues to substantially interfere with the public's ability to carry on its normal course of business. The director, therefore, extends the duration of this order to be in force through August 21, 2020.
