C. PROGRESS OF SECTION 1332 WAIVER - General

12. Provide an update on progress made in implementing and/or operating the approved 1332 waiver.

For the second quarter of 2021 the Oregon Reinsurance Program (ORP) has begun processing the health care claims for the seven eligible health insurance carriers on the Individual market. Next, the ORP conducted two public meetings for the consideration of the insurance industry and public at large. The first meeting, held on June 30, 2021 and sponsored by the Division of Financial Regulation , informed the public and insurance carriers concerning how the health care claims should be processed for the 2020 program year. Second, on July 20, 2021, we held the Public Forum in addition to the PPACA 1332 Waiver Extension informational meeting for the 2023-2027 program years. Finally, enrollment numbers remain stable and individual market premium pricing has been finalized for the 2022 program year.

Enrollment report

A total of 171,007 members were enrolled in individual ACA compliant plans, both on and off market, for the enrollment period ending June 30, 2021. Next, interest from health insurers looking to get into the individual market has grown in recent years. Oregon has had at least three carriers inquire about entering the Individual market.

Outreach

The ORP held two public meetings to gain consumer and industry input for the PPACA 1332 Waiver

Extension fort he State of Oregon DCBS. A total of 137 consumers attended both meetings virtually. Next the annual health care claims seminar was held on June 20, 2021 to instruct carriers on how to process their claims for the 2020 program year.

Rates

Rates for the individual market rose slightly by a average of 1.5% for the 2022 Program year.
