C. PROGRESS OF SECT	ION 1332 WAIVER - General			

The Oregon Reinsurance Program's PPACA 1332 Waiver has been operating within the Standard Terms and Conditions (STD) of the 'Departments' with no current plans to make any changes to the STD at this time. Enrollment has been robust and current funding levels will support the OPR for the 2023 program year.

#### **Enrollment report**

The 1st quarter enrollment for Individual ACA compliant plans ending March 31, 2023 for both On and Off Market totaled 168,993 members (On-exchange 133,230 and Off-Exchange 35,763). The Public Health Emergency ended May of 2023 may have caused a moderate .04 percent (7,319) reduction in enrollment from the previous year. Qualifying members from this group can find healthcare opportunities from the Oregon Health Authority's Medicaid programs. Oregon offers plans in all 36 counties (zones 1-7) with at least 4 and as high as 6 healthcare plans, in each zone.
