The Oregon Reinsurance Program's PPACA 1332 Waiver has been operating within the Standard Terms and Conditions (STD) of the 'Departments' with no current plans to make any changes to the STD at this time. Enrollment has been robust and current funding levels will support the Oregon Reinsurance Program for the 2024 program year.

#### **Enrollment report**

The 1st quarter enrollment for individual ACA compliant plans ending March 31, 2024 for both on- and off-exchange totaled 168,221 members (on-exchange 136,201) (off-exchange 32,020). Enrollment numbers are approximately one percent lower than March 31, 2023 (168,993), while on-exchange enrollment increased by 1.02 percent (2,971 members) and off-exchange enrollment fell by collectively by 4.85 percent (772 members) adjusted by member movement between exchanges.

Parameters for 2025
