The 3rd quarter enrollment for individual ACA compliant plans ending September 30, 2024 for both onand off-market totaled 164,337 members (on exchange 132,468) (off exchange 31,869). Qualifying members from this group can find healthcare opportunities from the Oregon Health Authority's Medicaid Benefit Health Programs whom fall within the 138 to 200 FPL bracket as of July 1, 2024.

ORP Reimbursements 2023 Program year

For the 2023 ORP Program year, \$111,036,203.16 was reimbursed back to the six eligible health insurance providers on the Oregon Health Insurance Marketplace. The parameters for the 2023 program year were an attachment point of \$95,000, coinsurance rate of 50 percent, and a cap of \$1,000,000. Oregon had 2,052 members reach the given parameters for the 2023 program year. The budget was set at \$114,100,000. During the Division audits, ORP did not detect material errors within the invoices submitted by the six health insurance companies (DFR audit had a 98% confidence rating). All reimbursements have been submitted as of November 21, 2024.
