all contracts or agreements entered into.

If the said principal complies with ORS 646.263 to 646.285, then this obligation shall be void; otherwise it
remains in full force and effect, unimpaired at all times, until 30 days from written notice by registered or certified
mail of cancellation from the surety to the director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services.
