Subject: Trillium Buyout

Mr. Keeling: On Tuesday, June 9th, 2015, I e-mailed you. I want to tell you again that TRILLIUM has been painfully dishonest with me. I reported them to ACUMENTRA, an "organization" of doctors (they would not give their names), who Medicare referred me to. Acumentra is "supposed" to investigate my complaints and make sure I have been treated fairly. In May, 2014, I received a letter from Acumentra saying nothing was wrong.

Apparently, I do NOT have a doctor at present, either.

A woman named [REDACTED] (I think her number is: [REDACTED]), did something horrendous to me, on purpose, and my doctor got furious with me! I want to believe that if there were a buyout, I would not have vicious, insane people making deadly decisions about my care. A news reporter told me Dr. Wuest, President of both Trillium and Slocum Orthopedics, might lose some of his crooked power.

I do not have ANY human family whatsoever and I am almost 75 and one half. I need rights. Thank you.
