Mr. Keeling, I was disturbed when the Coordinated Care Plan allowed for profit companies to participate. I am opposed to this sale. The amount of money at stake is massive, the oversight small and the opportunity for fraud huge. My main concern is that ALL services that are provided to the sickest and poorest of our population could be chosen because of cost with an eye to the bottom line instead of what is best for the person. These medicaid members do not have a choice. They must use the providers that are chosen by a third party. If the third party is driven by profit instead of quality care then the member will suffer. If there is going to be for profit CCO's at least keep them Oregon corporations where they can be better controlled.

I have been a transportation provider for a medicaid brokerage for more than 10 years. This brokerage is non profit and has always chosen the most appropriate care with pricing being secondary. I have copied my Representatives and Senators as I feel this is an issue that needs to be addressed at the State level.
