Subject: Definition Primary Care Services, "Primary Care," "Primary Care Provider" Draft Admin Rules

I have a few comments on (9) "Primary Care" and (10) "Primary care provider."

Under (9) please insert "chiropractic medicine"

Under (10) please insert "chiropractic physician"

Rational: The Oregon Board of Chiropractic Examiners based on our clinical training and scope of practice define doctors of chiropractic as "primary care physicians."

Stipulation: We would accept the requirement that **for an Oregon doctor of chiropractic to be considered a "Primary care provider" the chiropractic physician must be board certified in internal disorders and family practice, or pediatrics and/or hold a Master's in human nutrition and functional medicine.**
