The news that OID, too, may rescind the ACA's expansion of small group health insurance policies from "up to 50 employees" to "up to 100 employees" is very upsetting. I am the Controller for B&B Print Source, a print shop in Tigard. We have 67 employees and have done our best to secure the best insurance benefits for our employees at renewal each year. Each year it's been a battle to control premium costs while trying to keep our employees somewhat satisfied and it's getting more and more difficult each year. The only way we've been able to keep the level of coverage we currently have is by having the flexibility to alter plans as necessary to meet our budget. Losing that flexibility will make it EXTREMELY difficult to afford coverage for our employees. I hope it does not come to the point that we opt to pay the penalty rather than offer coverage to our employees and your help to ensure this doesn't happen is crucial.
