HB 4005 Major Provisions

Requirements for drug manufacturers

- Reports for certain drug price increases
- Reports for new specialty drugs
- Timely responses to DCBS follow-up questions
- Fees to cover DCBS costs for administering program

Requirement for health insurers

- Prescription drug cost information in rate filings

Requirements for DCBS

- Receive manufacturer reports, publish to website, exempt trade secret information
- Ensure compliance, impose civil penalties if necessary
- Establish process for consumers to inform Department of drug price increases
- Annual public hearings, report, recommendations to Legislature

Charter & Scope of Work

Initial Rulemaking Considerations

Rules required by HB 4005

- Definition of “new prescription drug” – Section 2(1)(f)
- Timeframes for DCBS requests for additional information and manufacturer responses – Section 2(7)(a)
- Establishing fees to be paid by manufacturers to pay DCBS costs – Section 2(12).

Rules that may be necessary

- Clarifying required content of reports and expectations for reporting manufacturers.
- Specifying meaning of “timely,” “timely manner,” “inaccurate or incomplete” – Section 2(8).
- Changes to health insurance rate review rules
- Establishing annual public hearings
- Schedule of civil penalties
