Thank you for the opportunity to provide additional comments regarding the definition of “net yearly increase”. Of the options provided, we believe option #2 (average WAC) is the most logical. It is our understanding that the definition of “net” can generally be summarized as the result after all factors have been taken into account. This concept seems to be most closely aligned with Option #2 which would take into account all variations throughout the year. This option also seems to be most reflective of what the market actually experiences in terms of cost as compared to other options.
