I have worked as a registered nurse for an allergy asthma clinic since 2015. We frequently prescribe Xolair for multiple conditions within our specialty to not only commercially insured patients but also Medicare and Medicaid patients. Over the past 10 years, Xolair is a medication that I speak to patients about confidently knowing they will have affordability options. I have always felt supported by Genentech to offer as much patient assistance as possible for patients being denied access to this medication. It was always surprising to me how much assistance patients were able to receive to stay on Xolair compared to other biologic medications used for similar conditions. I have always felt that patients were well supported with options to afford Xolair through Genentech Patient Foundation and the Xolair co-pay assistance program.
