



OR Mortgage Servicer License New Application Checklist (Company)

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GENERAL INFORMATION

Who Is Required to Have This License?

Any company that will be servicing an Oregon residential mortgage loan that is not exempted by law is required to have a mortgage servicer license prior to engaging in servicing activity per Section 3 of SB 98 passed during the 2017 Oregon legislative session.

Activities Authorized Under This License

This license authorizes the following activities...

- Third party first mortgage servicing
- Third party subordinate lien mortgage servicing
- First mortgage servicing
- Master Servicing
- Subordinate lien mortgage servicing

Pre-Requisites for License Applications

- None.

Oregon Division of Financial Regulation does not issue paper licenses for this license type. Licenses may be printed on the Division's website.

Document Uploads Guidance

Documents that must be uploaded to the *Document Uploads* section of the Company Form (MU1) in NMLS are indicated in the checklist below. When uploading documents:

- Follow the guidance in [Document Upload Descriptions and Examples](#).
- Only upload documents relevant to the company application.
- Only upload documents where there is a selectable document category. If inappropriate documents are uploaded that should not be, you will be contacted by your regulator and asked to remove them from NMLS.

- Do not upload the same company documents multiple times. Generally, unless the document is state-specific, if the document has already been uploaded for another state, a new upload is not required unless changes have been made.
- If a document previously uploaded has been revised, delete the old document and replace it with the new document (history of the old document will remain in NMLS).
- For state-specific documents (e.g., Surety Bonds), be sure to indicate the applicable state.

If applicant is a start-up company, only an initial statement of condition is required.
